



Vacation Rental Cleaning Checklist

- Make the bed and change the sheets.
- Wipe down surfaces, including countertops, tables, and shelves.
- Clean the bathroom, including the shower, sink, and toilet.
- Sweep and mop the floor.
- Empty the trash and replace the trash bags.
- Wipe down appliances, such as the refrigerator, stove, and microwave.
- Dust and polish any furniture.
- Wash dishes and put them away.
- Check for any damage and make any necessary repairs.

1-Month Checklist

- Double-check all appliances and faucets
- Replace any dimming or burnt-out light bulbs

3-6 Month Checklist

- Clean furniture fabric and curtains
- Deep clean the rugs and/or carpeting
- Deep clean behind the stove and refrigerator
